REGISTRATION

All participants are requested to register in advance by returning the enclosed 'Registration Form' duly completed along with the registration fee of Rs. 1800/- (One thousand eight hundred only) by November 30th, 2015. The registration fee should be paid by a demand draft made in favour of the 'Indian Council of Chemists' payable at Agra. Registration fee for accompanying adult (spouse & children) is Rs. 900/- (Nine hundred only) without kit. The registration form along with demand draft should be sent to Dr. M.K. ICC organises every year a half day symposium on topics related to recent advancements of Chemistry. This year too, ICC is organising a SYMPOSIUM ON RECENT ADVANCEMENTS IN ATMOSPHERIC CHEMISTRY RESEARCH during this year's ICC conference. It will be held on 27th December, in the pre lunch session open to all delegates. Some of the leading researchers in the field of Atmospheric Chemistry Research have already confirmed their participation. It will be an unique opportunity to attend this Symposium. Prof. Ajay Taneja, Head, University Department of Chemistry, Dr. B.R.A University, Agra, is the Chairman of this Symposium.

AWARDS

The Council gives the following awards every year:

1. **Life Time Achievement Award**, carrying a citation and Gold Medal to be given annually to a senior eminent scientist preferably above the age of 60 years, who has made distinguished contribution to any field of Chemical Sciences.
2. **Wahid Uddin Malik Memorial Award**, carrying a citation and cash award of Rs. 15,000, given annually to an eminent Chemical Scientist on the basis of his / her significant contribution in any field of Chemistry. The award has been instituted by Mr. Majorb Malik, son of Prof. W.U. Malik.
3. **Prof. S. P. Hiremath Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 25,000/- given annually to an eminent scientist actively engaged in any branch of Chemistry at National level on the basis of his/her significant contribution. The award has been instituted by Dr. (Mrs.) Ujjwala S. Hiremath, wife of Prof. S. P. Hiremath.
4. **Dr. Arvind Kumar Memorial Award**, carrying a citation and cash award of Rs. 10,000/-, given annually to an Indian Scientist, up to the age of 45 years, actively engaged in any area of Chemical Sciences at national level. The award has been instituted by Ms. Bharati Arvind, wife of Dr. Arvind Kumar.
5. **Prof. Kaza Somashekara Rao Award**, instituted in the memory of his wife **Smt. Kaza Indira Devi**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 10,000/- only for best Women Scientist in Chemistry.
6. **Prof. G. Gopala Rao Centenary Commemorative Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- given annually to one young researcher whose paper, presented in the Analytical Chemistry/Physical Chemistry section by rotation.
7. **Prof. S. C. Ameta Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- given annually to one young researcher whose paper, presented in the Physical Chemistry section.
8. **Prof. C.P. Bhasin Award**, instituted in the memory of his mother **Late Smt. Sudesh Bhasin**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best oral presentation in Inorganic Chemistry section.
9. **Dr. R. K. Agarwal Award**, instituted in the memory of his father **Late Sri Madhusudanji** carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best poster presentation in Inorganic Chemistry section.
10. **Dr. V. K. Sharma Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best oral presentation in Pharmaceutical Chemistry section. The award has been instituted by Dr. Bharat Parashar, Udaipur.
11. **Prof. G. L. Taleasa Award**, instituted in the memory of his father **Late Sri Nandlal Taleasa**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best oral presentation in Organic Chemistry section.
12. **Dr. G. D. Nigam Award**, instituted in the memory of his parents **Late Jaishree Gopalji**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best poster presentation in Anal. & Environmental Chemistry section.
13. **Prof. G. K. Chaturvedi Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best oral presentation in the field of coordination chemistry in Inorganic Chemistry section. The award has been instituted by Prof. G. K. Chaturvedi, Agra himself.
14. **Prof. A. P. Mishra Award**, instituted in the memory of his father **Late Sri Ram Pyare Mishra**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best oral presentation in Inorganic Chemistry Section preferably in the area of Bioinorganic / Medicinal Inorganic Chemistry.
15. **Prof. S.T. Nandibewoor Award**, instituted in the memory of his parents **Smt. & Shri T. Nandibewoor & Smt. & Shri V. Javali**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best oral presentation in Chemical Kinetics / Physical Chemistry Section.
16. **Prof. Sudhir K. Banerjee Memorial Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 2500/- only for Senior Scientist, who has made significant contribution in the field of Organic Chemistry. The award has been instituted by his wife Mrs. Aparna Banerjee, Udaipur.
17. **Prof. D. Ashok and Dr. M. Saranya Award**, instituted in the memory of their parents **Sri D. Gangaram and Smt. D. Shanikamma**, carrying a citation and cash award of Rs. 1000/- given annually to one young women researcher, up to the age of 35 years, whose oral paper is presented and defended in the Organic Chemistry Section.
18. **Woman Scientist Award**, carrying a cash award of Rs. 1500, a citation for best oral presentation in Anal and Environmental chemistry by **Dr. Kalpana** in the memory of her mother-in-law **Late Smt. Shanti Sinha**.
19. **Prof. H. J. Arnikar Award**, instituted by Prof. (Mrs.) N. S. Rajnikar in the memory of his teacher, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- only for best oral presentation in physical chemistry section preferably in the field of Nuclear / Electro / Adsorption Chemistry.
20. **Young Scientist Award**, The Council gives an award and a certificate to young scientists upto the age of 35 years for the best paper presented in oral and poster sessions separately in all the five sections. Some of the awards have been instituted for Best Oral presentations in (i) Inorganic Award chemistry section by Prof. M.M. Taqeeqhan, Hyderabad. (ii) Prof. V. Anantram, Vishakhapatnam in Physical Chemistry section.

(iii) **Prof. K. Soma Sekhara Rao**, Nagaland in Anal. and Environment/Chemistry section.

21. **Maximum Participation Award**, The Council gives a 'Maximum Participation Award' to the College/ Institution from where maximum number of delegates participate in the Conference with the exception of the Colleges/ Institutions of the city where the Conference is being organized. Prof. S. P. Hiremath, Dharwad has instituted this award.
